MEMORANDUM FOR ARMY ACQUISITION EXECUTIVE

SUBJECT: Delegation of Authority Pursuant to Title 10, United States Code Section 1706, Title XII of Public Law 101-510, National Defense Authorization Act for Fiscal Year 1991 (The Defense Acquisition Workforce Improvement Act)

In accordance with Title 10, United States Code Section 3013(f), and Title 10, United States Code Section 1706, Title XII of Public Law 101-510, National Defense Authorization Act for Fiscal Year 1991 (the Defense Acquisition Workforce Improvement Act (DAWIA)), I hereby authorize you to establish an Acquisition Career Program Board to advise you, in your capacity as the Army Acquisition Executive, in managing the accession, training, education, and career development of military and civilian personnel in the acquisition workforce and in selecting individuals for the Acquisition Corps under Section 1731 of the DAWIA. This provision also authorizes you, in your capacity as the Army Acquisition Executive, to establish a subordinate board structure in the department to which functions of the Army Acquisition Career Program Board may be delegated.

Proposals that alter existing personnel systems or processes, or create new ones, or that change personnel doctrine must be reviewed and approved by the Assistant Secretary for Manpower and Reserve Affairs and, as appropriate, coordinated by the Assistant Secretary with the Under Secretary of Defense (Personnel & Readiness) for approval.

This delegation shall remain in effect for three years from the date of the execution, unless earlier rescinded in writing by me.
