SUBJECT: Delegation of Authority for Position Requirements and Tenure Waivers

1. In accordance with the Defense Acquisition Workforce Improvement Act (Chapter 87 of Title 10 United States Code) and Department of Defense Instruction 5000.66, "Operation of the Defense Acquisition, Technology and Career Development Program," 21 December 2005, for all Key Leadership Positions (KLPs) that are filled by General Officers (GO), Senior Executive Service (SES), or Program Managers of Acquisition Category I, IA or II programs, I will remain as the final selection authority and approval authority for Position Requirements and Tenure Waivers.
2. I hereby delegate authority for Position Requirements and Tenure Waivers for all KLPs who are in functional lead positions below GO/SES to the Director, Acquisition Career Management. Further, I hereby delegate Position Requirements and Tenure Waiver approval authority for all Critical Acquisition Positions to the Deputy Director, Acquisition Career Management.
3. This delegation is effective immediately and expires two years from the date of this memorandum unless earlier revoked or suspended.
