

PARC Locations










Contingency Contracting

- **BACKGROUND: Modularity impacts CCO Mission & Structure**
 - **CCO Mission**
 - **Mission is still Life Support Contracting: food, water, shelter, sanitation**
 - Required in early stages
 - **Modularity = Austere Logistics tail**
 - More reliance on contracted services = increased mission for CCO's
 - **CCO Structure**
 - **Pre - Modularity = Embedded in units**
 - **Modularity**
 - Developed FDU to support contingency contracting
 - » FDU approval will allow assets to be put on a TOE
 - » TOE to be assigned to AFSC
 - » CCO will support AFSB Mission
 - **Pitfalls**
 - **Lack of a Joint Acquisition Review Board**
 - **Extremely High OPTEMPO**
 - **Minimal contracting infrastructure**



Command & Control



- ✓ PARC is on ASC TOE
- ✓ During Peacetime PARC is OPCON'd to ACA - PARC duties include IMA Mission, Contingency Planning for TSC & CCO Training
- ✓ During contingency some assets may remain OPCON to ACA to support ACA mission
- ✓ Duties include in Theatre Contracting
- ✓ Contracting assets deployed forward are – OPCON to the AFSB (if PARC is forward AFSB is O7)
- ✓ PARC can go into any theatre with any number of CCO teams
- ✓ ACA Staff includes a Deputy that steps up to perform PARC functions
