- The Army Field Support Brigade (AFSB) provides capabilities as modular components to support the expeditionary Army for the TSC and Army. It is the single point of contact to the Army/ASCC/TSC Commander for all Acquisition Logistics and Technology (ALT) capabilities.
- Designed to support the modular force by deploying a single, seamless fully integrated Planning Cell from within the AFSB to provide quick response and command and control of ALT capabilities across the spectrum of conflict.
- The AFSB is a significant change from the former AMC Forward concept and structure, and expands its scope to include Contracting capabilities and creates a permanent, small deployable all military organization by converting identified core positions from a TDA to a TOE structure.
- These regionally focused AFSBs will keep pace with contingency requirements in each theater, and reflects a change in focus from mostly logistics to a comprehensive ALT support. The consolidation of ALT provides a vanguard for the massive civilian contractors in the Deter/Engage phase of a contingency as well as for new fielding, modernization, modification work order and other system acquisition support.



CCO Mission

Mission:


- ❑ Serves as the Lead Unit for contingency contracting upon designation by the Regional Combatant Commander (RCC) or the Army Service Component Command (ASCC) serving as the Joint Forces Land Component Commander (JFLCC).
- ❑ Serves as the theater warfighting PARC to plan and command all Joint contracting mission support for that plan.
- ❑ Serves as Army Commander's contracting advisor.
- ❑ Plans for and coordinates all contracting functions within a theater.
- ❑ Prepares and coordinates execution of the theater contracting support plan.
- ❑ Provides command, control, and supervision of all assigned and attached contingency contracting units.
- ❑ Provides planning assistance to the supported command for local procurement.
- ❑ Modular 4 person contracting team is the basic unit of support.

HQ PARC Structure



- The Contracting Commander/PARC commands one or more contracting battalions, each capable of deploying multiple modular contracting teams, forming and controlling Joint contracting offices, and exercising operational control (OPCON) over all Army contracting teams deployed in theater.
- The Contracting Commander/PARC serves as the Army Commander's contracting advisor, plans for and coordinates all contracting functions within a theater of operation, and prepares, integrates with AFSB plans, and coordinates execution of the theater contracting support plan. Provides operational command, control, and supervision to all assigned and attached contracting elements. Provides planning assistance to the supported command and /or host nations, and local procurement.
- The Contracting Commander/PARC in conjunction with the Army Contracting Agency is responsible for providing all contracting support for Army installations.

- CCO BN participates in all supported unit deliberate and crisis action planning.
- CCO BN review: unit concepts of operations, OPLANs, CONPLANs, and theater contracting support plan.
- CCO BN publishes contracting support plans for each Corps and Division OPLAN and CONPLAN.
- CCO BN personnel advise Corps and Division maneuver unit commanders and staffs on contracting support.





Figure 1-6. Lines of Authority
