SUBJECT: Use of Operations and Maintenance, Army (OMA) Funds for Memorials on Army Installations

1. Reference Army Regulation 1-33 (The Army Memorial Program), dated 30 May 2006.
2. This clarifies the authority in AR 1-33, which establishes policies for the memorialization of Army military and civilian personnel with records of outstanding and honorable service. In accordance with AR 1-33, appropriated OMA funds may be used to purchase memorial markers that are suited to affixing to structures when a facility or property is dedicated to memorialization of Army personnel. Typically, such markers consist of a plaque with a brass or bronze plate affixed to a building, stone or other marker. A sign, stone or marble slab (either engraved or with plate attached) or other outdoor device can be used to mark a street or open area. Such markers are to be of nominal value.
