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SUBJECT: US Army Acquisition Support Center (USAASC) Career Acquisition Management Portal (CAMP)

1. Purpose. Overview of CAMP
2. Facts. Members of the Acquisition, Logistics and Technology Workforce (ALTWF) utilize the tools within Career Acquisition Personnel and Position Management Information System (CAPPMIS) to better manage, coordinate and plan their acquisition careers. The existing CAPPMIS suite of applications already integrates several career management tools, including the Acquisition Career Record Brief (ACRB), the Individual Development Plan (IDP), the Senior Rater Potential Evaluation (SRPE), Acquisition Professional Development System (AAPDS), Military Approved Positions (MAPL) and Certification Management System (CMS) modules. The CAMP consolidates and reduces the effort required of the individual workforce member to locate and use tools available to them.

A consolidated system with centralized access controls and a single point-of-entry also addresses U.S. Army requirements for improved security and reduced costs. Users are able to login to CAMP using their existing CAPPMIS login or their Common Access Card. Advances in technology have created an opportunity to combine additional career management tools of USAASC programs into a single coherent entity, the CAMP. The CAMP as a whole could then be migrated to the Acquisition Business Enterprise (ABE) Hub. Future migration into the ABE Hub allows UAASC to take advantage of the Department of Defense (DoD) level authentication, verification and certification environment present within the Hub. Moving the CAMP into the ABE Hub environment would also allow all ALTWF members' immediate access to other acquisition programs hosted within the ABE Hub, without requiring additional logins or moving between separate websites.
