In accordance with the above references, I hereby redelegate the expedited hiring authority for shortage category acquisition positions to you. This authority may not be further delegated.

This authority must be exercised in strict compliance to the above references. This authority must be used to fill shortage category acquisition positions at the YA-02/YA-03 and comparable levels, with highly qualified individuals. Proper documentation must be maintained for all appointments made under this authority. Quarterly reports must be submitted electronically to the point of contact designated below. Submission of the first report should cover the period March 1, 2009–June 30, 2009 and is due July 8, 2009. Future reports will be due on the 8th day of the month following the end of the quarter.

This authority expires on September 30, 2012 unless otherwise revoked or suspended.
