SUBJECT: Project/Product Manager (PM) and Acquisition Director (Acq Dir) of the Year Awards

Request nominations for the Fiscal Year 2008 PM and Acq Dir of the Year Awards. These awards recognize Army PMs and Acquisition Directors whose outstanding contributions and achievements merit special recognition.

Any military or civilian PM (Lieutenant Colonel/GS-14 and Colonel/GS-15), as governed by *Department of Defense Directive Number 5000.2 Subject: The Defense Acquisition System*, is eligible to compete for the PM of the Year Award. Acquisition Directors occupying positions on the Command Select List are eligible to compete for the Acq Dir of the Year Award.

The contributions made, which culminated during the period of **April 17, 2007, through April 16, 2008**, should be considered for each nominated PM or Acq Dir. No more than one PM in each category (Project and Product) shall be submitted from each nominating Program Executive Office (PEO) or organization. No more than one Acq Dir at the Lieutenant Colonel level and Colonel level will be accepted from each nominating acquisition command.

Each participating PEO or acquisition command will ensure all subordinate organizations have the opportunity to nominate an eligible individual for this competition as well.

Please submit your nominations to the U.S. Army Acquisition Support Center through the Web-based Call for Nominations Application at <http://www.usaasc.info/aac/awards/pm/call/>. Please provide 1-2 digital photo images (300 dpi or higher resolution) of the person you have nominated to receive the award. The photos/images should be in headshot format (official photo format, if available) for individual nominees.

Ensure the nominees' names are complete, spelled correctly and written out as the nominee would like his/her name to appear on a certificate, award or program. **Include the nominating organization name, employing**

organization, group title, office title, activity, duty organization and a nomination point of contact with a telephone number and e-mail address provided. The summary describing the nominees' accomplishment(s) must not exceed two single-spaced type-written pages. Describe your nominees' significant accomplishments and ensure your nominations are submitted no later than close of business on **May 15, 2008**.
