
SUBJECT: Nominations for the David Packard Excellence in Acquisition Award

1. Nominations are requested for the David Packard Excellence in Acquisition Award for contributions completed in calendar year 2009. This award recognizes civilian and/or military organizations, groups or teams that have demonstrated superior accomplishments significantly contributing to best Defense Acquisition practices.
2. Nominations must specify an award category appropriate for the achievement. Award categories include: Program Management; Communications/Computer Systems; Information Technology; Contracting (includes Construction); Purchasing; Industrial Property Management; Systems Planning, Research, Development and Engineering; Test and Evaluation; Manufacturing; Production and Quality Assurance; Acquisition Logistics; Business, Cost Estimating and Financial Management; and Auditing. Award categories will be used to assist in the evaluation of the nominations. Nominations should reference the enclosed nomination criteria and provide supporting information. Whenever possible, quantifiable metrics, such as savings and outcome measures, are especially desired. **No more than one nomination in each category shall be submitted by the same organization and/or addressee. Each nomination shall be submitted in only one category.**
3. All nominations will be accepted by the U.S. Army Acquisition Support Center through the Web-based Call for Nominations application at <http://www.usaasc.info/aac/awards/packard/call/>. Only one letter of endorsement will be accepted for each nomination. Nominations should be submitted no later than close of business **May 26, 2010**.
