

2011 CDG/AAF Program Requirements

If you are selected by the Board for the Year Group 2011 CDG/AAF Program, you will be assigned to the U.S. Army Acquisition Support Center (USAASC) for a three-year period beginning early March 2011. You will work with your mentor to plan out your three years before the Program actually begins. We have developmental assignments in the Warren, Huntsville and Washington, D.C., etc. areas, so you will work in a developmental assignment close to your current duty location for 6 months to one-year. During the three-year period, you will have approximately 4 developmental assignments. All of this is worked in conjunction with you and your mentor. In addition, there are other Program requirements which are the training part of the assignment. Here are the specifics on the training:

- ❖ Intermediate Qualifications Course (Huntsville Alabama) for 4-weeks
- ❖ 2 Executive Leadership Courses at Darden (University of Virginia, Charlottesville) for 1-week each
- ❖ Congressional Operations Course (Washington, D.C.) for 5-days
- ❖ PMT 352B DAU Course for 5-weeks (if you have not already taken it)
- ❖ HQs Assignment- Six-Month TDY to Washington, D.C. for a developmental assignment at the Pentagon or Crystal City, VA or HQs AMC (Schedule to move to Huntsville 2011.)
- ❖ Apply to the Program Manager/Acquisition Key Billet Board in second and third year of the CDG/AAF Program. (If on the Program Management Track).
