

SUBJECT: Nominations for the Eighth Annual Army Life Cycle Logistician Award.

1. This memorandum serves as a formal reminder to submit nominations for the Eighth Annual Army Life Cycle Logistician Award. This award is intended to recognize a Logistician for excellence in the field of Life Cycle Logistics and achievements in improving the Total Life Cycle Systems Management process. Achievements can be in the area of materiel/information/weapon systems, or life cycle logistics processes (i.e., supply, maintenance, distribution, integrated logistics support, etc.).
2. The award is open to all U.S. Army military and civilian Life Cycle Logisticians. The achievements must have occurred between June 30, 2011 and June 30, 2012. Personnel processing the award are not eligible to receive the award. The Army Acquisition Executive will present the Life Cycle Logistician Award at the annual acquisition award ceremony scheduled for October 21, 2012.
