

## **Reclassification Results from November 2012 Board**

The U.S. Army Acquisition Support Center (USAASC) convened a 51C Non-Commissioned Officer (NCO) reclassification board November 2012 at Fort Belvoir, VA. It was administered by the 51C Proponent Office. A total of 27 candidates were selected for reclassification.
