



Colonel Lee MacGregor

Deputy Director, U.S. Army Acquisition Support Center

Colonel Lee MacGregor has served as the Deputy Director of the U.S. Army Acquisition Support Center (USAASC) since July 2014. USAASC is a Direct Reporting Unit responsible for providing oversight of the Army Acquisition Corps (AAC) and the Army Acquisition Workforce, providing support to the program executive offices in the areas of human resources, resource management (manpower and budget), program structure, and acquisition information management. The USAASC reports directly to the assistant secretary of the Army (Acquisition, Logistics and Technology) (ASA(ALT)) and Army acquisition executive, as well as the military deputy to the ASA(ALT).

Colonel MacGregor graduated and received his commission from the Virginia Military Institute in 1992 as a military intelligence officer detailed to the Infantry. He started his career as a platoon leader, scout platoon leader and executive officer for the 4th Battalion, 27th Infantry Regiment, 25th Infantry Division at Schofield Barracks, Hawaii; and for the 3rd Battalion, 75th Ranger Regiment at Fort Benning, Georgia. He also served in a variety of leadership positions in the 10th Mountain Division (Light) at Fort Drum, New York including the S-2 (Intelligence) for 2nd Battalion, 22nd Infantry Regiment; the S-4 (Logistics) followed by company commander for 110th Military Intelligence Battalion; and as the G-2 (Intelligence) Plans Officer for Headquarters, 10th Mountain Division (Light).

Colonel MacGregor joined the AAC in 2000 serving as a contingency contracting officer for U.S. Army Signal Command at Fort Huachuca, Arizona. As an acquisition officer, he has held several leadership positions including the chief of contracting for the Flight Concepts Division at Fort Eustis, Virginia; the chief of operations for Sustainment Division at the Army Capabilities Integration Center at Fort Monroe, Virginia; and as the commander of Army Contracting Command-Qatar. His operational deployments include Operation Joint Forge, Bosnia-Herzegovina; Operation Enduring Freedom, Afghanistan; and Operation Iraqi Freedom, Iraq.

Colonel MacGregor is a Distinguished Military Graduate of Virginia Military Institute receiving a B.A. in economics and business. He also holds a MBA with a concentration in acquisition and program management from the Naval Postgraduate School. His military education includes graduating from the Infantry Officer Basic Course; Military Intelligence Officer Advanced Course; the Combined Army and Services Staff School; Pre-Command Course; Command and

General Staff College; Nuclear, Biological and Chemical Course; Survival, Evasion, Resistance and Escape Course; and the Jungle Operations Training Course.

Colonel MacGregor's awards and decorations include the Bronze Star Medal; Defense Meritorious Service Medal; Meritorious Service Medal with three oak leaf clusters; Joint Commendation Medal; Army Commendation Medal with two oak leaf clusters; Army Achievement Medal; Armed Forces Expeditionary Medal; NATO Medal; Afghanistan Campaign Medal; Iraq Campaign Medal; Global War on Terrorism Expeditionary Medal; Global War on Terrorism Service Medal; National Defense Service Medal; Ranger Tab; Expert Infantryman Badge; Air Assault Badge; Parachutist Badge; Canadian Parachutist Badge; and German Armed Forces Badge (Gold).

Colonel MacGregor is also a member of the AAC and is Level III certified in Contracting.
