SUBJECT: Acquisition Intelligence Career Occupation Program Foundational Credential

This memo supports Department of Defense (DoD) award of the foundational credential for Acquisition Intelligence within the Acquisition Intelligence Career Occupation Program. Establishing foundational training and credentials recognizes the importance of ensuring that those intelligence personnel tasked to be directly involved in acquisition processes have the skills they need to be successful.


Award of the foundational credential for Acquisition Intelligence requires:

- a. One year of experience in an Acquisition Intelligence position that is designated by the DoD component Acquisition Intelligence Career Occupation program manager;
- b. DAU ACQ 101 Fundamentals of Systems Acquisition Management;
- c. DAU CLR 101 Introduction to the Joint Capabilities Integration and Development System; and
- d. DAU ACQ 110 Acquisition Intelligence.

DoD Component Acquisition Intelligence Career Occupation Program managers may add additional requirements to support their unique mission needs. It is expected that award of this credential will be reflected in Component official personnel records system(s) in order to maintain visibility and track over time this important skill set.

The DAU ACQ 110 course is newly developed and in final stages of DAU approval. During the period leading-up to this approval, we recognize the valuable training offered by the United States Air Force (AF) Acquisition Intelligence Formal Training Unit (IFTU) as equivalent training. Individuals who successfully completed the ACQ 110 pilot course and those who completed the AF Acquisition IFTU prior to ACQ 110 formal training course approval are judged to meet the core training requirement of ACQ 110.

The Acquisition Intelligence Career Occupation Program guide is a key resource to support general program execution.
