- Degree Concentration in MSL Government Procurement
- Program can be completed within 12-18 months
- 24 credit hour program with curriculum that focuses on experiential learning with an emphasis on writing assignments and active learning rather than mere content delivery.
- Offers a dynamic and collaborative learning environment to network with JD and LLM students, experienced faculty, government and industry professionals.
- Open to eligible FA51 Officers who meet the Army Acquisition Advanced Civil Schooling criteria; completion of Key Development assignment preferred
- LSAT or GRE not required
- Available for August 2021 start
- Must apply through Acquisition ACS Program with acceptance letter from GWU Law School
