ARMY ACQUISITION CORPS MEMBERSHIP (AAC)



Professional recognition within the Army Acquisition community which is earned through experience, education, training, and seniority.

★ **AAC Membership** is a requirement for the appointment of **Critical Acquisition Positions (CAP)**, **Key Leadership Positions (KLP)** and is highly encouraged for all AAW professionals who meet the eligibility criteria.

Supervisor's Role for AAC: Coach AAW professionals and reinforce the importance of obtaining AAC membership should they aspire to more senior-level positions.



One-third of AAW are AAC Corps Members

MEMBERSHIP ELIGIBILITY

- ✓ Rank: GS13+, Majors+, Sergeant First Class+.
- ✓ Level II certified in any career field but must be your primary.
- ✓ 4 years of acquisition experience.
- ✓ Bachelor Degree+ from accredited university.
- ✓ 24 semester hours of business or 24 semester hours of technical training and 12 semester hours of business.

HOW TO APPLY

Supervisors should advise AAW professionals to submit an AAC Membership System submission request.
