

BACK-TO-BASICS: LIFE CYCLE LOGISTICS

Why Modernize?

The **Life Cycle Logistics (LCL)** Functional Area updated training, education, and experience requirements for their community as part of the initiative to modernize the implementation of the **Defense Acquisition Workforce Improvement Act (DAWIA)** certification framework. At the core of BtB is lifelong learning – required training will be streamlined and supplemented by a rich array of role-specific training to meet individual needs.



Proposed Certification Requirements: Training

- **Foundational:** ACQ 1010, LOG 1000, LOG 104, LOG 105, LOG 200, LOG 235, LOG 201/V
- **Advanced:** ACQ 202, LOG 206, ACQ 2030/V, LOG 340/V, LOG 350/V, ACQ 315/V

LCL Acquisition Experience

- **Foundational:** 2 years
- **Advanced:** 5 years

Education: No degree requirement for certification

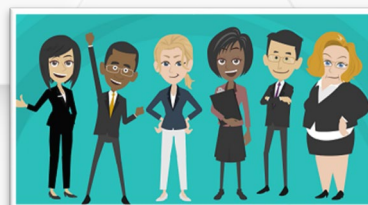
CLP Requirement: 80 hours every two years

More Time to Complete...

Planning is underway to potentially expand the current two year grace period to complete certification requirements to three years for **Foundational** and four years for **Advanced**.

What's New in February '22?

- The updated framework features two tiers of certification: **Foundational** and **Advanced**.
- Certification training hours have been reduced by approximately 24%.
- After certification, the **Defense Acquisition Credential** Program provides job-relevant, point-of-need training in specific acquisition topics.
