##### Acquisition Career Management Advocate

- A senior level acquisition leader, generally at the senior executive service and military general officer or colonel levels
- Partners with Army DACM office to ensure AAW awareness of policies, programs and resources
- Provides a critical, strategic organizational level perspective
- Advocates on behalf of their organization's AAW



#### ACM

##### Acquisition Career Manager

- Responds to employee Help Request submissions
- Partners with OAPs in support of AAW career-related information
- Facilitates SRPE issues
- Processes DAU training seat scheduling
- Processes certification and waiver requests
- Conducts outreach and information presentations
