

# Army Professional Contracting FA Credentials

## Army Standard



- ❑ Standard across Army - Developed by ODASA(P) Future Workforce Capabilities Office
- ❑ Focuses on professional competencies (i.e. business acumen, risk management, interpersonal skills, etc.)
- ❑ Establishes a 'professional standard' across the Army Contracting Enterprise; serve as a compliment to the DoD Technical Credentials
- ❑ Required for an Army Warrant if an individual is not currently Level II or Level III certified under the legacy certification structure (see Army Warrant Policy (v7, DEC 2021) on [Procurement.Army.Mil](https://www.acquisition.gov/procurement/procurement.army.mil))
- ❑ Easy Access – No cost
  - ❑ Short courses (ranging from 2 – 6 hours) that can be taken over time
  - ❑ Easily accessible through DAU and Army e-Learning
