- Responsible for planning, testing, training and fielding Army systems and equipment.
- Leads a multi-disciplinary, multi-agency integrated product team of professional acquisition personnel across multiple sites nationwide.
- · Serves as the military interface between the operational forces, industry and defense agencies for Army system development.
- Aviation Officers can apply for the Test Pilot program. As part of this program, Officers will ensure materiel and technology-based solutions address all operational effectiveness and safety criteria.

FA51 AOC C- CONTRACTING

Lead detachments that enable the Army Contracting Command to provide contracting support worldwide to expeditionary operations throughout the entire spectrum of military operations.
